The 2018-2019 District 103 Director has a goal for District 103 to become a "**PRESIDENT'S DISTINGUISHED**" district by June 30, 2019. This goal can be achieved when each member, leader and club chooses to achieve S.U.C.C.E.S.S. Here's how:

### **MEMBERS**

Members who achieve S.U.C.C.E.S.S. during the 2018-2019 club year will:

- Achieve at least one (1) communication award from Toastmasters International
- Earn at least one (1) leadership award from Toastmasters International
- Pay your October 1 membership renewal dues **BEFORE** time
- Pay your April 1 membership renewal dues **BEFORE** time
- Appear as a "Sponsor" on at least three (3) new membership applications\*
- Submit at least three (3) District 103 *Club Ambassador* forms
- Attend at least one (1) outside of your club event (i.e. conference or TLI)



\*The role of “Sponsor” on a new membership application (item 400) means you encouraged a new member to join Toastmasters. The new member can join any Toastmasters club anywhere in the world. However, your name must appear on their new membership application in the “Sponsor of New, Reinstated, or Dual Member” section. Toastmasters International will record the number of applications for which you appear in the “Sponsor” section. District 103 Toastmasters will use their data to confirm this criterion.

## **CLUBS**

Clubs which achieve S.U.C.C.E.S.S. during the 2018-2019 club year will:

- Have at least three (3) members which achieved the **MEMBER** criteria above

### **PLUS:**

- Have four (4) or more club officers trained during Round 1 (June 1, 2018 – August 31, 2018)
- Have four (4) or more club officers trained during Round 2 (December 1, 2018 – February 28, 2018)
- Submit their 2019-2020 *Club Officer List* into the TI website no later than June 10
- Submit proxies for Toastmasters International Convention no later than June 10
- Submit their 2019-2020 *Club Success Plan* no later than June 10

To honor each **MEMBER** and **CLUB** which accomplishes the criteria of this district-sponsored incentive, each **MEMBER** will receive:

- An “Express Your G.I.F.T.S.” medallion at the District 103 Summer Toastmasters Leadership Institute (TLI) and recognition on the District 103 Toastmasters website.

Each **CLUB** will receive:

- An “Express Your G.I.F.T.S.” plaque at the District 103 Summer Toastmasters Leadership Institute (TLI) and recognition on the District 103 Toastmasters website.

The 2018-2019 District 103 Director believes when **MEMBERS** and **CLUBS** “Express Your G.I.F.T.S.” this club year – more participation, excitement, and fulfillment will be experienced from the benefits of the Toastmasters program. This, in turn, will lead our clubs to becoming **DISTINGUISHED** or higher, along with District 103 becoming “**PRESIDENT’S DISTINGUISHED**”
