

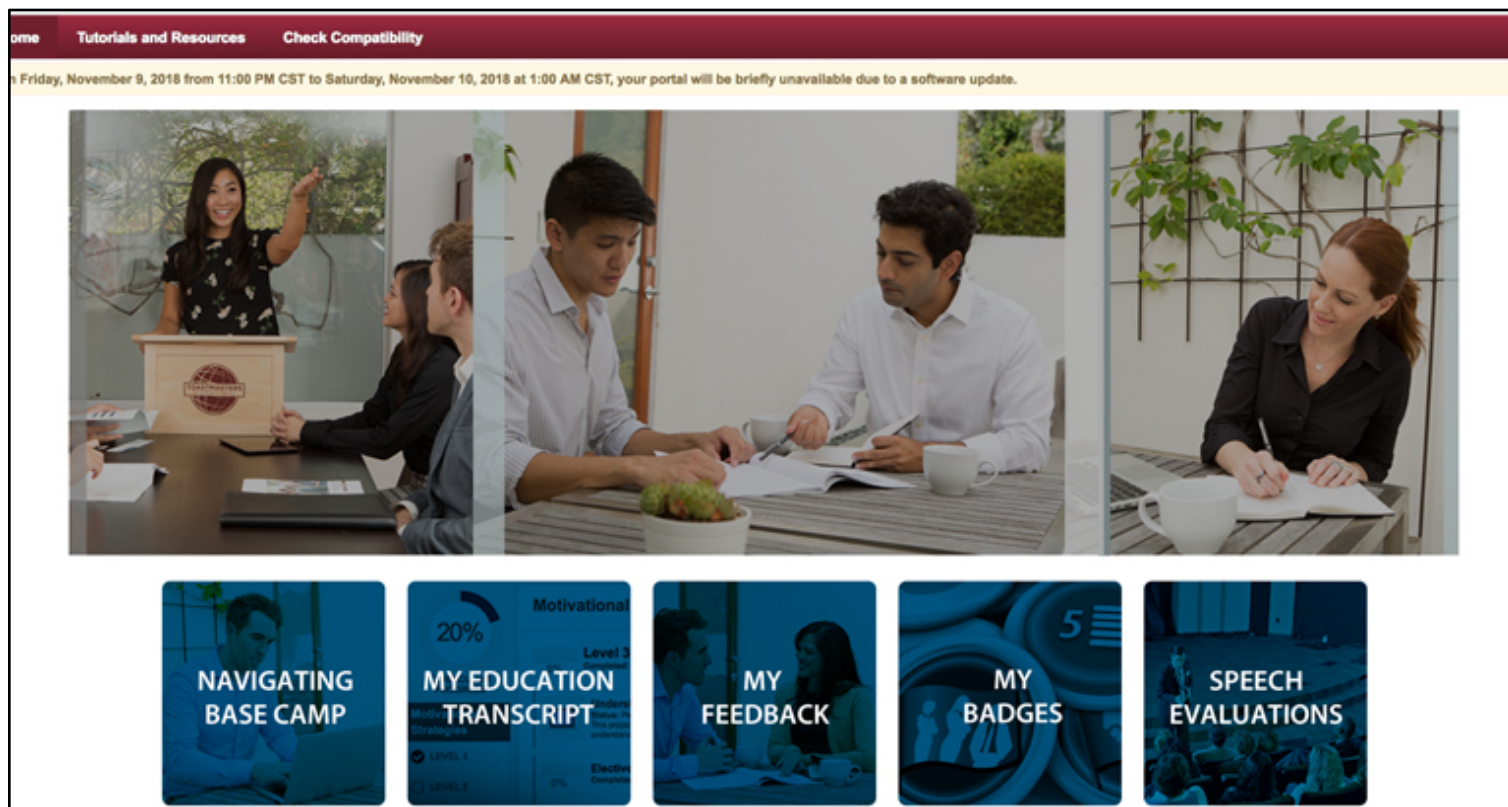

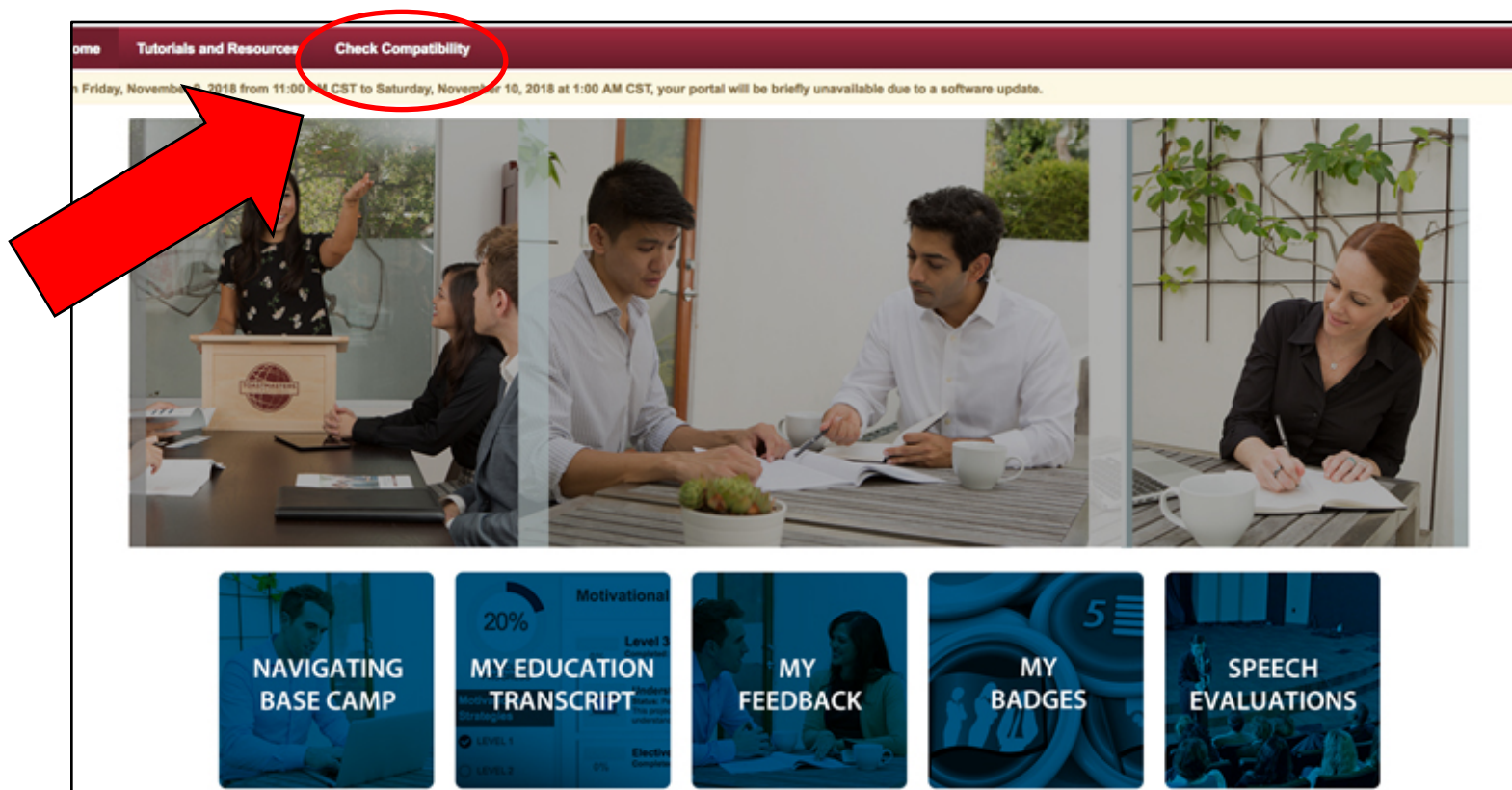


# Step 1. Log in to Base Camp



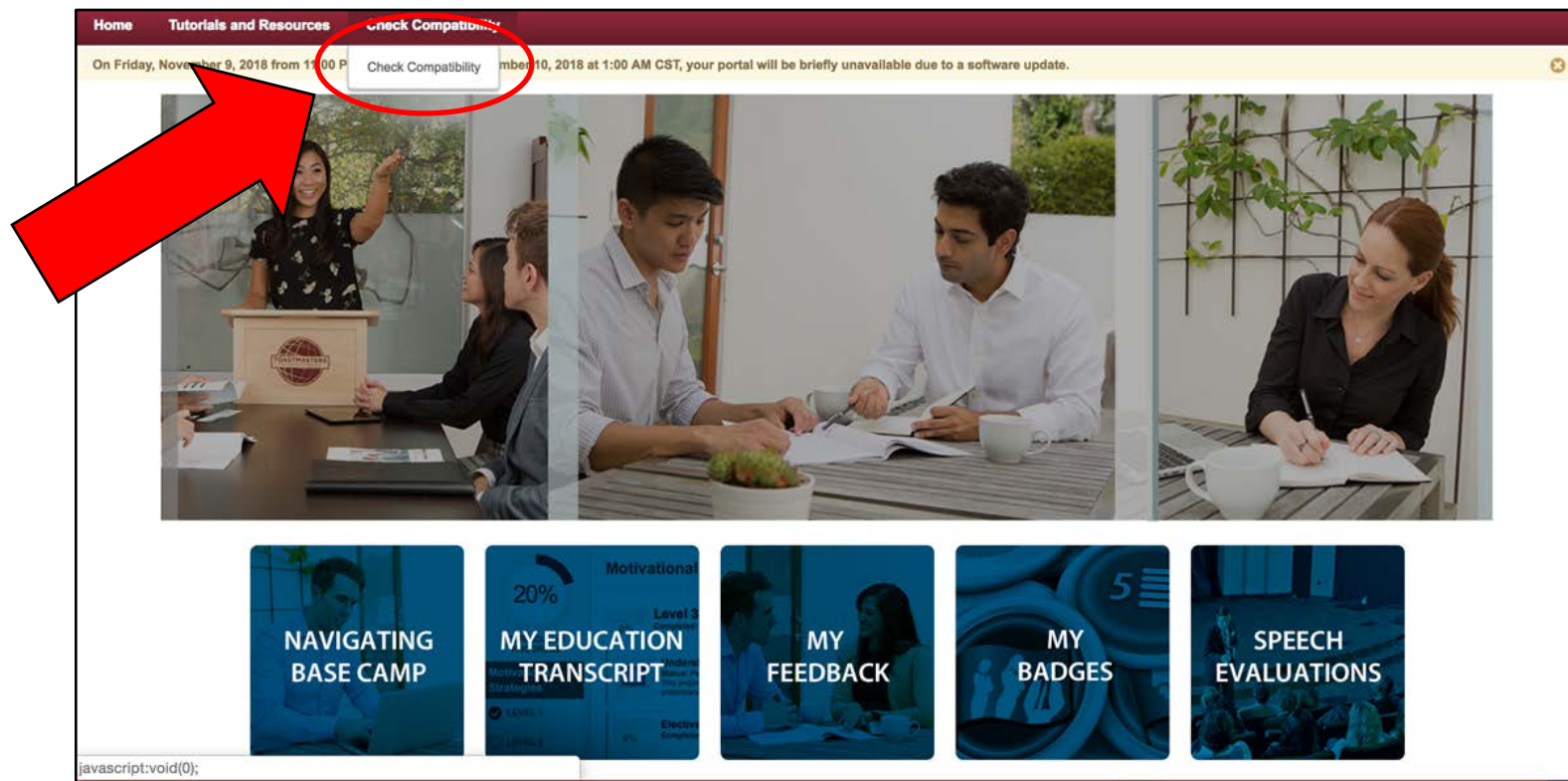
# Step 2. Hover over “Check Compatibility”

Hover your mouse over the words “Check Compatibility”.



# Step 3. Click on “Check Compatibility”

Click on the little white drop-down box that appears.



# Step 4. Click Each Green Box, One-at-a-Time


Pathways will check your computer settings to determine if anything needs to be reconfigured.
